This one-day training course is designed for those people responsible for the stormwater management requirements during construction and for those previously certified in Erosion Control. The course covers the stormwater regulatory requirements, development and implementation of Stormwater Management Plans (SWMP), and preparing for and conducting a comprehensive inspection of a CDPHE *Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activity* permitted site.

The course will also cover methods of correcting site deficiencies, legal requirements for stormwater management during construction, review of the types of Best Management Practices (BMP's) for specific situations to control erosion and sedimentation, development and implementation of the SWMP, conducting detailed and comprehensive inspections (focus: management applications) and addressing site deficiencies.
