Course Descriptions

Traffic Control Supervisors Training Course

Cost: CCA Members - \$225.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$350.00 per person

Recertification Only - \$210.00 per person

This 2 day course is designed to give participants state-of-the-art knowledge of the entire process of planning, designing, installing, maintaining, and monitoring traffic control for work zones. This program complies with the Colorado Department of Transportation's Standard Specification 630.09. The **Traffic Control Supervisor** course is required of all supervisors working on CDOT projects. This two day course will be provided for those supervisors who have not had the time to take the course because of their work load. All course materials will be provided along with lunch.

CDL- B Written Test Preparation, Driving Practice and Driving Test Class

Cost: \$2,000.00 per person

This class is divided into two parts. The first part is a half day class which prepares the student for taking the Colorado Commercial Drivers (CDL) Written test for a Class - B CDL. This is a half day class which covers the following topics: General Knowledge information, Air Brakes, Tanker and Hazardous Material Endorsements and requirements for obtaining a Class - B CDL. The second part includes five days of training in Greeley where the student will receive driving instruction, practice and testing. **Here is the Training Schedule:** After the first class the student is required to take and pass the written CDL- B test at the Division of Motor Vehicles. Upon receiving their Class - B Permit the student must obtain a CDL Medical Card. Once the permit and medical card are obtained the student will attend a five day driving class in Greeley Colorado sometime between March and July 2010. Upon successfully passing the Driving Test the student will receive their Colorado Class - B CDL.

Girder Erection Training

Cost: CCA Members - \$225.00 per person

If you erect structural girders for bridges and other structures or supervise or manage those who do then this seminar is a must to attend. This comprehensive overview of the process of Girder Erection provides an entire "tool box" of knowledge to safely and efficiently handle and erect girders. Topics covered are: bridge components, girder erection plans, safety, layout, superstructure erection, bearings, connections and troubleshooting erection problems.

Economics Of Construction Contracting

This highly rated 4 hour seminar will provide a "Big Picture" overview of the Economics of Construction Contracting and we'll show you how little things on the job make a big financial difference. You'll learn about what it takes financially to succeed in the construction industry, you'll have a better understanding of what contractors' profit margins really are, you'll see how what you do makes a real difference that can benefit both you and your employer and you'll be more valuable to your employer. We will also discuss methods for tracking project costs, financial analysis, what bankers and bonding companies and other market forces and trends have to do with profit. This seminar is a must for superintendents, foremen, lead persons and anyone else who has an impact on project profits.

Fall Protection Competent Person Training

Cost: CCA Member - \$65.00 per person

Non CCA Member - \$100.00 per person

Designed to raise the participant's awareness of the latest safety requirements for fall protection systems, using criteria pertaining to the construction industry. OSHA requirements will be discussed specific to the following: Subpart "M" Fall Protection Standard,

Subpart "L" Scaffolding, Subpart "X" Ladders, How to inspect Fall Protection Equipment, Applicability of the Fall Protection Standard to construction activities, Training requirements of the Standard and use of common Fall Protection equipment.

CDPHE Dewatering Requirements

Cost: \$100.00 per person

This half day course provides guidance for personnel who are involved in dewatering operations for groundwater encountered during construction. Some of the topics covered in this training are: CDPS permitting requirements, dewatering methods, treatment techniques, materials and equipment management, discharge sampling, operations monitoring, and other information to assist contractors in complying with a project's CDPHE-WQCD construction dewatering permit.

Best Management Practices for Construction in Waterways

Cost: \$100.00 per person

Construction activities performed in waterways may impact water quality and therefore Best Management Practices (BMPs) are necessary to minimize these impacts. This course will provide detailed information about the design, installation, maintenance and inspection of BMPs that may be used to prevent or control erosion and sedimentation during construction activities in waterways.

First Aid/CPR

Cost: CCA Members - \$85.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$100.00 per person

This 8-hour class is designed for the person who has not previously attended a First Aid/CPR course. You will learn how to provide First Aid and CPR in emergencies. Upon successful completion of this course, you will receive a First Aid/CPR card which is good for two years.

CDOT - ECS Training & Certification

Cost: \$200.00 per person

This is a one-day seminar on stormwater and erosion control techniques, procedures and legal requirements of the new Phase II Stormwater Regulations. This includes an intensive look at stormwater and erosion control techniques, practices and minimum requirements. This class will focus on advanced legal requirements, supervisory duties, paperwork requirements and CDOT specific requirements that are applicable to any size construction project. **Upon successful completion of this course, attendees will receive a Stormwater Supervisor certification.**

Trenching & Excavation "Competent Person"

Cost: CCA Members - \$65.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$100.00

This is the popular OSHA-required training course for trenching and excavation "competent persons." This training includes: Soil classification & testing, Overview of OSHA Standard 29 CFR 1926, excavation safety procedures, proper use of protective systems, employee protection systems and responsibilities of the competent person.

Confined Space "Competent Person" Training

Cost: CCA Members - \$65.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$100.00

This is the OSHA required training class for confined space "competent person" and includes: Overview of OSHA Standards, confined space permit requirements and policy procedures for working in confined spaces, confined space policy, testing atmospheres of confined space, responsibilities of the competent person and more.

OSHA 10-Hour "Basic Safety"

Cost: CCA Members - \$175.00

Non CCA Members - \$250.00

This one and a half day seminar is a must for all construction supervisors. Jobsite violations will be reviewed and the 29 CFR Part 1926 Standards are highlighted. This seminar will include certification of completion with an OSHA wallet card. This seminar will pay for itself many times over if you are inspected just once by OSHA.

Introduction to Supervision

Cost: CCA Members - \$150.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$200.00 per person

This course is designed for the new construction foreman or lead person who is making the transition from a craft position to a construction supervisor. The company needs the new supervisor to get up to speed quickly and this course provides those skills to set up them up to succeed. At this course attendees will receive training on the following topics: Your attitude and the crew, Fitting basics fundamentals into your style, Getting a first-rate crew & retaining them, Keeping all the bases covered, Short interval schedules and other tools, Responsibilities, actions & MUCH MORE. This is a MUST course for the new or soon to become new construction lead person or foreman.

DOT Alcohol and Drug Supervisor Awareness Training

Cost: CCA Members - \$350.00 per person

Non CCA Members - \$200.00 per person

The Department Of Transportation regulations requires all supervisory personnel and drivers shall receive at least 60 minutes of training on alcohol misuse awareness and at least 60 minutes of training on drug use awareness. This class covers physical, behavioral, speech, and performance indicators of probable alcohol misuse and use of drugs. The class also instructs Supervisors on how to take action if they have reason to believe that substance abuse is affecting a driver's job performance or behavior in any manner.
