

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Town of Avon, Colorado, will receive sealed bids for the Community Heat Recovery Project for the Town of Avon, Colorado. Bids will be received at the Office of the Town Engineer, Avon Municipal Complex, P.O. Box 975, One Lake Street, Avon, Colorado, 81620 until 2:00 pm local time, on March 19, 2010, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Construction for which bids will be received includes:

**Project Description:** The Work consists of construction of a heat recovery system for the Town of Avon, extracting heat from the wastewater effluent at the Avon Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) and distributed via hot water supply and return piping to the recreation center for pool heating. Generally, the contract includes all temporary and permanent site, architectural, structural, process mechanical, HVAC, building services, electrical, and instrumentation and control work and testing, training, and commissioning as specified in the Construction Drawings and Specifications. The project includes demolition, new manholes an utility work, two new buildings, approximately 2,800 linear feet of insulated, welded steel pipe and fittings, tie-in to existing facilities at the WWTF and Recreation Center, control system, site restoration, and all other appurtenances.

The Contract Documents, including Plans and Specifications, are on file at the Office of the Town Engineer, Town of Avon Municipal Complex, One Lake Street, Avon, Colorado. Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents are available from the Town of Avon upon receipt of \$200.00 per set. Deposits will not be returned. Contractors are requested to contact the Town of Avon at (970) 748-4080 to reserve/order copies of Plans and Specifications 24 hours prior to pick up.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Friday, March 5, 2010 at 10:00 am at the Avon Town Municipal Complex, One Lake Street, Avon, Colorado.

A certified check or bank draft, on a responsible, solvent bank, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and a recognized Colorado licensed Surety Company, payable to the Town of Avon, Colorado, in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid, shall be submitted with each bid as security that the Bidder to whom the contract may be awarded will enter into a contract in accordance with this notice, and give bond as hereinafter provided.

No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids, without the consent of the Town of Avon, for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled Bid Opening. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds in the full amount of the bid or proposal.

All bids must be submitted in writing on the forms provided, and signed by the Bidder or his duly authorized agent.

By submitting a bid, the bidder certifies pursuant to C.R.S. § 8-17.5-102(1) that, at the time of bid submission, it does not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien and that the contractor has participated or attempted to participate in the Basic Pilot Program that is administered by the United States Department of Homeland Security in order to verify that it does not employ any illegal aliens.

The Town of Avon reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities in bidding, and to make Award in such a manner as they may deem right and proper for the best interest of the Town of Avon.
